

New England and Vermont Clubs Host Volume Sale

The second year of the Northeast Jersey Classic and Breeders Sale proved to be as successful as the first for the New England and Vermont Jersey breeders associations, which hosted the event. The 267 lots that were struck off this year on April 25 sold for an average of \$1,644.76—about \$60 more than last year—and a gross of \$439,150. The venue again featured several, special-pedigreed, elite individuals presented in a tie-up style sale format and a larger group of individuals sold in a commercial sale format. All but three of the consignments—two milking cows and a choice—that sold at the Vermont State Fairgrounds in Rutland were uncalved females.

One of the two cows that sold through the venue was the high seller. John R. Miller, Leeds, Maine, placed the final bid of \$4,100 on Billings Minister Martina. Slotted at the front of the catalog as Lot 1, the Very Good-88% aged cow is sired by Select-Scott Minister-ET, GJPI -141. “Martina” is due to Hawarden Impuls Premier, GJPI +52, is early June. She sold with a \$3,000 heifer contract from consignor, Billings Farm and Museum, Woodstock, Vt., which agreed to purchase a daughter out of her from the “Premier” mating when it is three months-of-age or another daughter by a mutually-agreeable sire born within the next two years.

“Martina” has a two lactation m.e. average of 15,708–849–651.

She has five Excellent maternal sisters. Included in this group are Billings Legion Mini Me, Excellent-95%, Grand Champion of the 2007 Eastern States Exposition, and Billings Vindication Mallory, Excellent-92%, Reserve Intermediate Champion of the 2009 New York Spring Carousel. Both have records over 20,100 lbs. milk, 990 lbs. fat and 700 lbs. protein.

Their dam, Billings Berretta Mocha-ET, is an Excellent-93% daughter of Mason Boomer Sooner Berretta, GJPI -48, with seven lactations and a best record of 4-9

305 18,920 5.4% 1,105 3.7% 696 100DCR. The next dam is an Excellent-91% naturally polled daughter of Mighty Master, JPI -112. The next two dams are Very Good-84% and Excellent-90%, respectively.

Michael Heath, Westminster, Md., purchased the second high seller, Kellogg Bay Davinity-ET, for \$3,600. The four-month-old daughter of Hollylane R Response-ET, JPI -110, hails from the “Veronica” cow family.

“Davinity’s” dam is an Excellent-90% daughter of Bovi-Lact First Prize-ET, JPI -116, with 19,200 lbs. milk, 1,099 lbs. fat and 673 lbs. protein at 4-9. Her grandam, Arethusa Veronicas Dasher-ET, Excellent-95%, has five lactations—two of them over 26,700 lbs. milk, 1,500 lbs. fat and 990 lbs. protein. “Dasher” has more than 30 Excellent maternal sisters. One of them, Arethusa Response Vivid-ET, Excellent-94%, is the reigning Grand Champion of the Royal Agricultural Winter Fair (RAWF).

“Davinity’s” third dam is Huronia Centurion Veronica 20J, Excellent-97%. She was Reserve National Grand Champion in 2002 and National Grand Champion in 2004. “Veronica” was also named Supreme Champion of World Dairy Expo in 2006 and twice earned the laurel at the Pennsylvania All-American Dairy Show. She was named the inaugural Cow of the Year by Jersey Canada in 2011 and selected to represent her sire, Sooner Centurion-ET, GJPI -51, in *The Art of Fine Breeding* contest in 2008.

“Davinity” was consigned by Joseph H. Allen, Panton, Vt.

Billings Farm and Museum consigned the third high seller as well, a second choice female sired by Rock Ella Impression-ET, GJPI -98, and out of Billings LS Boo Boo. James P. Hoskens, De Pere, Wis., purchased the choice of nine pregnancies due in March 2015 for \$3,300.

“Boo Boo” is an Excellent-92% daughter of Lester Sambo, GJPI -60, with six lactations and a best record of 7-6 305 20,100 4.8% 957 3.6% 725 102DCR. Her maternal sister, Billings Remake Bounty,

Excellent-93%, was named Overall Premier Performance Cow of the All American Jersey Show and Reserve All American Senior Two-Year-Old in 2008. She has 20,160 lbs. milk, 1,251 lbs. fat and 873 lbs. protein at 5-6. A full sister to “Boo Boo” is Excellent-92% and has 19,320 lbs. milk, 1,068 lbs. fat and 705 lbs. protein at 4-5.

“Boo Boo’s” dam is an Excellent-92% “Berretta” daughter with eight lactations and a best record of 5-10 305 17,180 5.4% 935 3.9% 671 100DCR. The next dam is an Excellent-91% daughter of Highland Duncan Lester, GJPI -114. The next six dams are Very Good or Excellent.

Medallion Jerseys of Shoreham, Vt., purchased the fourth high seller, Kellogg-Bay Gunman Glowstick-ET, another consignment from Allen, for \$3,100. The 16-month-old daughter of Rapid Bay Gunman-ET, JPI -128, sold due to sexed “Premier” in mid-September.

“Glowstick’s” maternal sister, Kellogg-Bay Amedeo Gladys-ET, Excellent-92%, is the 2010 All American Intermediate Yearling and the 2011 Reserve Junior All American Senior Two-Year-Old. She has 19,550 lbs. milk, 826 lbs. fat and 735 lbs. protein at 4-7.

Her dam, Oblong Valley Furor Gidget-ET, Very Good-88%, has two records over 23,000 lbs. milk and a best record of 24,270 lbs. milk, 1,401 lbs. fat and 1,008 lbs. protein at 3-11. She has three Excellent maternal sisters. Their dam, Alexvale Gennies Gadget, Excellent-92%, was named Junior Champion of the RAWF in 2000 and the Central National Jersey Show the following year. She stood third in the senior two-year-old class at the Mid-Atlantic Regional Jersey Show in 2002. “Gadget’s” maternal sister, Alexvale Made Me Giggle-ET, EX 96-3E (CAN), was Grand Champion of the RAWF and the Central National Jersey Show in 2008 and is the dam of Avonlea CF GT Balls of Fire-ET, GJPI -21.

“Glowstick’s” fourth dam is Excellent and made 20,004 lbs. milk, 803 lbs. fat and 743 lbs. protein at 4-7 in Canada.

Thirty-four Jersey breeders from 11 states border-to-border made purchases. The volume buyer of the day was Daniel Z. Stoltzfus, Honey Brook, Pa., who purchased 89 head for \$134,800.
