## Well-Known Families High Sellers for Northeast Sale

Consignments from popular cow families brought premium prices at the third Northeast Jersey Classic and Breeders Sale on April 23, 2016. The sale was held at a new venue this year-Dusty Creek Farm—owned by Gerald and Diane Colvin of Wallingford, Vt. Several, specialpedigreed elite animals were presented tie-up style and a larger group of individuals sold commercial sale style. In all, 273 lots of Registered Jerseys were struck off for an average of \$1,429.03 and a gross of \$390,125. All but four of the consignments were bred heifers, open yearlings or heifer calves. Thirty-five buyers from 16 states coast-to-coast made purchases.

of the country, Jeff Adams of Touchet, Wash., purchased the high seller, Molly Brook Calypso Fabulous, for \$3,750. The 11-month-old daughter of Ahlem Prescott Calypso-ET, GJPI +144, hails from the "Flower" cow family developed by consignor, Molly Brook Farms of West Danville, Vt.

She has GPTAs of +1,032M, +33F and +36P and is +145 for GJPI. Her dam is an Excellent-90% daughter of All Lynns Louie Valentino-ET, GJPI +129, with a three lactation m.e. average of 21,182–1,049–768. Her grandam, Molly Brook Jace Fresh-ET, Very Good-87%, has six lactations—half over 21,000 lbs. milk—and a best record of 5-7 305 22,440 4.8% 1,080 3.7% 823 101DCR.

"Fresh" has four Excellent and six Very Good maternal sisters. Several have ranked among the breed's best for genetic merit. Included in this group is Molly Brook Jace Forget-Me-Not-ET, Very Good-88%, with 23,810 lbs. milk, 1,224 lbs. fat and 870 lbs. protein at 4-9. Another full sister, Molly Brook Jace Frost-ET, was the high-selling female of The All American Jersey Sale in 2004. A full brother, Molly Brook Jace Freeze-ET, GJPI +42, was syndicated at the same sale in Louisville, Ky. Their

dam is the breed's former #1 cow for JPI, Molly Brook Fair Frost, Excellent-90%, with three lactations over 21,000 lbs. milk and a best record of 25,490 lbs. milk, 1,046 lbs. protein and 911 lbs. protein at 3-3.

The fourth dam of "Fabulous" is Molly Brook Frosty Fame-ET, Excellent-92%, with a top record of 4-1 305 27,410 4.7% 1,296 3.5% 950 99DCR. The next dam, Molly Brook Sooner Fame-ET, Excellent-91%, has 21,490 lbs. milk, 1,180 lbs. fat and 844 lbs. protein at 3-0. She has eight proven sons. The sixth dam is matriarch, Molly Brook Fascinator Flower, Excellent-90%, with lifetime credits of 193,832 lbs. milk, 10,852 lbs. fat and 7,589 lbs. protein. She has offspring on every continent but Antarctica and was voted third in the *Jersey Journal* Great Cow Contest in 2000.

The heifer cataloged as Lot 1, Dutch Hollow Mack Cheryl 6020-ET, commanded the second-high price of the day at \$3,100. Mole Hill Dairy of Dayton, Va., placed the last bid on the nine-month-old daughter of Missiska Mackenzie-ET, GJPI +187. She is from the "Cherish" cow family developed by consignor Paul C. Chittenden of Dutch Hollow Farm, Schodack Landing, N.Y.

"Cheryl 6020" has GPTAs of +561M, +46F and +31P and a GJPI of +145. She tested free for JH1 and JH2 and is +1.5 for Type and +3.7 for Productive Life. Her dam, Dutch Hollow Valentino Cheryl-ET, Excellent-90%, has a best record of 2-8 305 3x 24,660 4.3% 1,066 3.3% 803 102DCR. "Cheryl" has six maternal brothers in A.I. and several maternal sisters ranked on the top genetic lists. Included in this group is Dutch Hollow Louie Charity, Very Good-86%, with 26,150 lbs. milk, 1,232 lbs. fat and 896 lbs. protein at 2-10 and numerous sons in A.I. A full sister, Dutch Hollow Valentino Cher-ET, was the second highseller of the National Heifer Sale in 2011 and today ranks among the top 1.5% for GJPI with an index of +139.

The next dam is matriarch, Dutch Hollow GM Cherish, Excellent-90%. The daughter of Dutch Hollow Gold Medal-P-ET, GJPI -22, has four lactations—all over 22,900 lbs. milk—and a best record of 4-9 305 3x 28,810 4.2% 1,207 3.6% 1,023 102DCR. The third dam of "Cherish 6020" is a Very Good-85% daughter of Rock Maple Brook Montana-ET, GJPI -56, with an m.e. average of 25,118—1,098–851 on two lactations. Her Very Good-84% fifth dam has 20,330 lbs. milk, 784 lbs. fat and 764 lbs. protein at 2-9.

Two lots sold for the third high price of the day—\$3,000. Nebraska Jersey breeder Grant Cast of Beaver Crossing purchased

one of them, Billings Verbatim Sugar. The Very Good-85% daughter of Arethusa Verbatim Response-ET, GJPI -107, sold due to sexed Hawarden Impuls Premier, GJPI +63, in mid-July. She has an m.e. of 16,845–876–653 on her first lactation at 1-9.

"Sugar" is backed by a prize-winning pedigree. Her dam, Milo Centurion Sadie-ET, Excellent-93%, was Honorable Mention Grand Champion of the Vermont State Show in 2013. She has two lactations over 19,400 lbs. milk, 870 lbs. fat and 680 lbs. protein. "Sadie" has six Excellent maternal sisters; four have earned Reserve All American laurels. One of them, Milo Vindication Season-ET, Excellent-94%, was Reserve All American Senior Three-Year-Old in 2009 and All-Canadian Mature Cow in 2013. A full sister, Milo Centurion Sassafrass-ET, Excellent-93%, was Reserve Junior National Grand Champion in 2012.

"Sugar's" grandam, Bri-Lin Rens Sofie, Excellent-90%, has 21,505 lbs. milk, 1,117 lbs. fat and 815 lbs. protein at 4-4. She was named Jersey Cow of the Year by Jersey Canada in 2012 and recently placed seventh in the 2015 Jersey Journal Great Cow Contest. Several of "Sofie's" maternal sisters have also earned prizes on the tanbark trail. Bri-Lin Renaissance Salsa-ET, Excellent-95%, was Reserve All-American Five-Year-Old in 2006. Bri-Lin Ren Sadie-ET, Excellent-95%, was nominated All-Canadian Junior Three-Year-Old in 2002 and tapped Grand Champion of the New York Spring Carousel the following year. She stood third in the fiveyear-old class at The All American Jersey Show in 2005.

"Sugar's" third dam, Bri-Lin Imperial Snow, VG 86 (CAN), earned a 10-star brood cow award from Jersey Canada (continued to page xx)

The eight-month-old daughter of Forest Glen Volcano Viper, GJPI +189, has GPTAs of +931M, +40F and +44P and is +179 for GJPI. Three of her maternal sisters ranked on the list of the Top 300 JPI Heifers on sale day. Their dam is a Very Good-80% daughter of All Lynns Legal Visionary-ET, GJPI +183, who ranks among the top 1.5% cows for GJPI with an index of +143.

"Comsa's" grandam, Oomsdale Gratitude Country CC {2}-ET, Excellent-90%, has a best record of 3-7 305 3x 21,430 4.6% 984 3.9% 828 100DCR. She has nine sons in A.I. Her third dam is Oomsdale Gordo Goldie Gratitude {1}, Excellent-90%, with a best record of 26,940 lbs. milk, 1,142 lbs. fat and 852 lbs. protein at 3-10 and numerous sons in A.I. sampling

The next seven dams are Very Good or Excellent. Her fifth dam is an Excellent-92% daughter of Rebob Duncan Hermitage-ET, GJPI -107, with four records over 20,000 lbs. milk and a top record of 4-6 305 3x 25,830 5.3% 1,372 3.8% 969 DHIR. Her ninth dam, Oomsdale Gen-Ola Goldie-P, Excellent-94%, has 10 lactations and made a best record of 19,210 lbs. milk, 831 lbs. fat and 736 lbs. protein at 10-6.

"Comsa {4}" was consigned by Michael Arend Ooms, Valatie, N.Y.
