Citation A Daughter Tops Northeast Classic Sale

For the fourth time, the New England Jersey Breeders hosted the Northeast Jersey Classic and Breeders Sale as a combination of a small group of special-pedigreed tie-up animals and then a large commercial group of individuals. The sale was held for the second consecutive year at Dusty Creek Farm, owned by Gerald and Diane Colvin of Wallingford, Vt.

At day's end, 273 lots of Registered Jerseys were struck off for an average of \$1,404.76 and a gross of \$385,500. Thirty-six buyers from 10 states coast-to-coast made purchases.

Mapleline Citation Barbara, an 11-month-old calf, captured the attention of the crowd as she entered the ring. The straight-lined, strong, and wide young calf was purchased for \$4,400.

Sired by BW Citation A-ET, GPI +121, "Barbara" is out of a Very Good-84% daughter of Wetumpka Impuls Lance, GJPI -17. She produced a top record of 20,570 lbs. milk, 981 lbs. fat and 797 lbs. protein at 4-0. The next dam is an Excellent-90% daughter of Golden Boy of Ferreira, GJPI -22. She has a five lactation m.e. average of 20,035—937—746 with a best record of 22,740 lbs. milk, 1,052 lbs. fat and 817 lbs. protein.

The next dam is also Excellent and has a top record at 6-2 of age of 23,020 lbs. milk, 1,016 lbs. fat and 858 lbs. protein.

"Barbara" was consigned by Paul and John Kokoski, Hadley, Mass.

Billings Farm & Museum, Woodstock, Vt., sold the next three high sellers.

Poulin Farms purchased Billings Joel Salsa-ET for \$3,700. The September calf is sired by Guimo Joel-ET, GJPI -37, and hails from the maternal line of Pearlmont Impuls Daffy.

Her dam, Pearlmont Venerable Sweetness, also sold in the sale and returned

She is appraised Excellent-91% and recently completed a 3-1 lactation of 19,460 lbs. milk, 868 lbs. fat and 694 lbs. protein. Her dam is a Very Good-87% daughter of All Lynns Restore Vibrant-ET, GJPI +78, with a 5-1 record of 20,140 lbs. milk, 804 lbs. fat and 719 lbs. protein.

The next dam is Excellent-90% with three lactations exceeding 18,000 lbs. milk actual and a daughter of "Daffy."

Billings Velocity Dixie-ET was the third high-selling heifer of the sale for \$3,150. She was purchased by Jersey junior Sophia Zina, Hadley, Mass. She is the grand-daughter of John and Elaine Kokoski of Mapleline Farm.

"Dixie" is a junior yearling sired by Arethusa Jade Velocity-ET, GJPI -126, and hails maternally from the world-famous Huronia Centurion Veronica 20J.

Her dam is Budjon-Vail Vincent Delicate-ET, Excellent-90%. She produced a 3-0 record of 16,130 lbs. milk, 937 lbs. fat and 596 lbs. protein. Her grandam is an Excellent-91% daughter of Bridon Remake Comerica-ET, GJPI -109, with a top record of 16,570 lbs. milk, 771 lbs. fat and 588 lbs. protein at 4-2.

The next dam is the one and only "Veronica." Appraised Excellent-97%, she has many accolades to her name including winner of the 2015 *Jersey Journal* Great Cow Contest, National Grand Champion, Supreme Champion of World Dairy Expo and the Royal Winter Fair. As well, she has many sons and grandsons in A.I., and also more than 30 Excellent daughters to date.

Selling for the fourth high price of \$3,000 was Billings Joel Bulghur-ET, a September calf consigned by Billings Farm & Museum. She was purchased by Jerry, Wanda and Katarina Emerich, Mooers, N.Y.

Sired by "Joel," the calf is out of Billings LS Boo Boo, Excellent-93%. Off-

She is backed by an Excellent-91% daughter of Highland Duncan Lester-ET, GJPI -91.
